DESCRIPTION:

A new state-of-the-art building is being constructed on the "Golf Mall" area of the Liberal Arts Campus. The modern facility will house both academic and administrative offices. The instructional portion of the complex will provide needed "smart" classrooms for the Creative Arts and Applied Science, History and Political Science, and Public Service Departments. Additionally, the facility will house the Superintendent's offices as well as other administrative offices. Construction is complete on the relocation and improvement of site utilities including replacement of obsolete data and telecommunication lines. Construction on the structure began in September 2006 and is expected to be completed in the first quarter of 2008.
